As you can see, installation of the new church sign has begun! We have raised 84% of the \$55,000 needed which leaves us with just under \$9,000 to raise. The church council voted to release the needed money from the general fund to cover the remaining cost so that we could get it installed. Insights into Matthew 10:42 in the ELCA Context

In the ELCA tradition, Matthew 10:42 is understood as a call to **radical hospitality and the recognition of Christ in others**. The verse — “And whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is My disciple, truly I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward” — is part of Jesus’ Missionary Discourse, where he commissions the Twelve to preach, heal, and face persecution.

Theological meaning

ELCA teaching emphasizes that welcoming Jesus’ disciples is equivalent to welcoming Jesus himself and the Father (Matt 10:40–41). The “cup of cold water” is a culturally significant gesture in first-century Palestine, symbolizing thoughtful, costly care in a context where fresh water was scarce. This small act becomes a sacramental sign of spiritual devotion, linking physical hospitality to divine communion.

Faith and action

For the ELCA, this passage affirms that **faith is lived out in tangible acts of love and welcome**. Hospitality is not just courtesy, but a sacred obligation rooted in God’s own covenantal hospitality (e.g., Abraham, Rebekah, Elijah). It challenges the honor–shame culture of the time to focus on inner love rather than outward displays of piety.

Application in the ELCA mission

In ELCA mission work, Matthew 10:42 is often applied to:

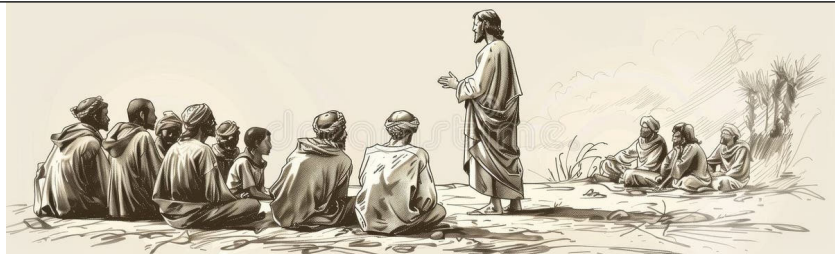
- **Welcoming missionaries and church partners** — recognizing their presence as Christ’s presence.
- **Supporting the marginalized** — seeing “little ones” as Christ’s humble followers, not just children.
- **Small acts of service** — even modest gestures of care are valued by God, reflecting the inclusive nature of the Gospel.

Communal and missional reflection

The ELCA’s emphasis on the church as the body of Christ means that Matthew 10:42 also speaks to **how congregations and mission teams treat one another**. It calls for a culture of mutual care, where every member is seen as a bearer of Christ’s mission. This aligns with the ELCA’s mission to “go and make disciples” while embodying the values of the Kingdom in daily life.

Summary

In the ELCA, Matthew 10:42 is a reminder that **God’s reward is not lost for any act of genuine welcome or service to a disciple**. It is a call to live out the Gospel through hospitality, to see Christ in others, and to integrate mission into everyday relationships.
